Race of Complainant

Charge

The officer was suspended for Conduct, Language, and Police Image. While on duty he used profanity towards a civilian several times. M

The officer was suspended for Conduct, knowledge of the laws, police image, handling of firearms, criminal law, unfavorable conduct, and cooperation with other authority. PO discharged his AR-15 style rifle in his residence, fled the scene, misplaced the weapon, failed to report it immediately, and made false statements to the investigators. M

The officer was suspended for use of force, disobedience of orders, and false statement. PO used pepper spray on a prisoner, who was restrained, and did not activate bwc. Cameras revealed that the accounts of what occurred were inaccurate. M

Exonerated: The alleged incident did occur, but the actions of the officer were justified, legal and proper.

Sustained: A preponderance of the evidence shows an officer violated any law; regulation; directive, guideline, policy, or procedure issued by the Attorney General or County Prosecutor; agency protocol; standard operating procedure, rule, or training.

Not Sustained: The investigation failed to disclose sufficient evidence to clearly prove or disprove the allegation.

Unfounded: A preponderance of the evidence shows that the alleged incident did not occur.
